2. Principles Report - K. Drury
  - a. Outcome of 5A & 5B - Approved in 2018 election
    - i. Accountability committee forming on how to distribute funds
      1. Beginning Jan/Feb 2019
    - ii. LPE likely to be getting the marquee - will help with special school announcements and twitter posts
  - b. Discussed adding to our current school name to enhance/further define our identity as a Leader In Me school
    - i. "Vision for school" - who we are and what is our purpose
    - ii. First discussed with BLT: use of "Leadership" in our name, academy vs school (Legacy Point Leadership Academy vs Legacy Point Leadership School)
    - iii. SAC discussed at length; several members expressed that Academy sounds too "charter school", not consistent with current identity
    - iv. Input from teachers, LPE committees, parents, community to be considered in changing the name
    - v. Survey/input processes in 2019-2020 school year and allow everyone to standardize the lighthouse principles for another school year
    - vi. Discussed value of waiting to implement any name addition until 2020-2021 school year
